SUMMER KIDZONE

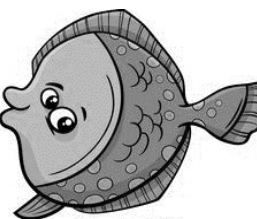
Volunteers are required to help with KidZone over July and August.

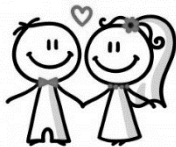

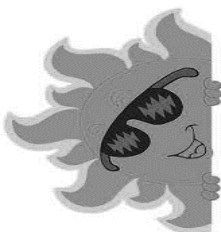
