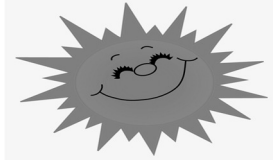
CALLING ALL STUDENTS!

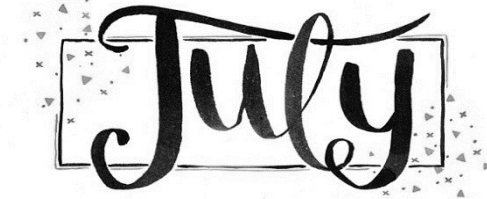
