LEPROSY MISSION

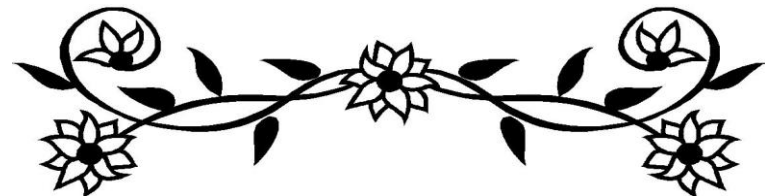

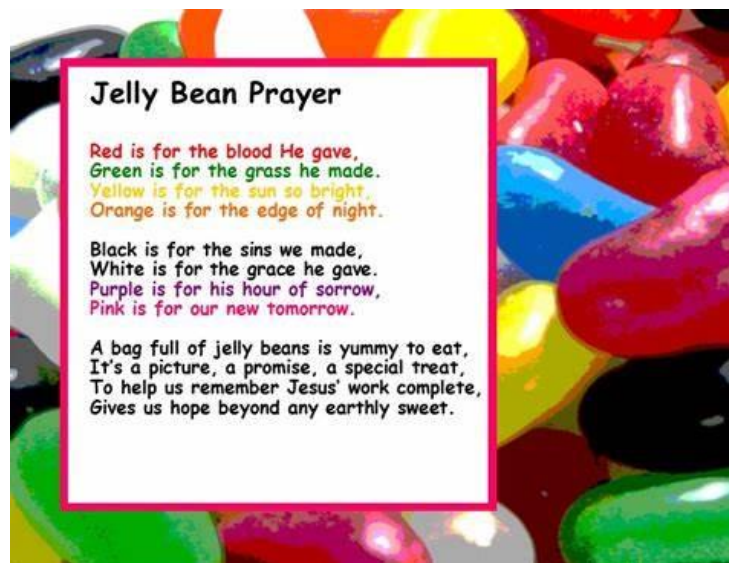
