Morning watch will meet on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July at 10.45 am in the Session Room.



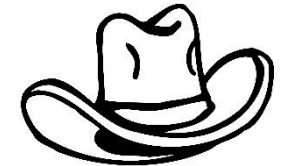
## KIDZONE
